YOUR ROLE WILL BE TO:

Player Development:

- Design and deliver high-quality coaching sessions tailored to the needs and abilities of senior academy players, focusing on skill development, game understanding, and tactical awareness.
- Provide individualized coaching and feedback to support the growth and progression of each player within the academy.

Teams:

- Lead and manage academy teams during training sessions, matches, and tournaments, instilling a culture of discipline, teamwork, and excellence.
- Collaborate with other coaching staff to ensure a cohesive and integrated approach to player development across all levels of the academy.

Talent Identification and Recruitment:

- Work closely with talent identification staff to identify and recruit talented young players to the academy, both locally and regionally.
- Develop and maintain relationships with local clubs, schools, and representative teams to identify and nurture potential academy recruits.

Performance Analysis:

- Utilize performance analysis tools and methodologies to review and evaluate player and team performance, identifying areas for improvement and development.
- Work with performance analysis staff to integrate data-driven insights into coaching sessions and player feedback.

- Pursue opportunities for professional development and accreditation to enhance coaching knowledge and skills.
